Summary of professional experience

Over 20 years' experience in biodiversity conservation and community development, with primary focus on community-based initiatives in the Tibetan Plateau region of China and in the mountains of Central Asia. Acting Director of the Mountain Societies Research Institute, University of Central Asia (UCA) and Research Associate at the Institute of Asian Research, University of British Columbia (UBC). Long experience in project implementation as well as academic research in grasslands, wildlife ecology, and pastoralism; community conservation; development projects focused on enhancing pastoralists' livelihoods and well-being including education, health and poverty alleviation; protected area management including community co-management; horizontal policy analysis; and capacity building across many administrative levels. Has led the work of the non-profit organization Plateau Perspectives since 1998, and served as consultant for World Wildlife Fund (WWF), Fauna and Flora International (FFI) and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP). In 2013 served as Chief Technical Advisor for the GEF-supported Qinghai Biodiversity Conservation Project, which sought to strengthen management effectiveness of the protected area system in Qinghai, China.
