# Jenny – Hinduism and Christianity: divine nature insights

## Jenny's Theological Presentation

- Core thesis: Traditional Christian belief in immortal soul contradicts biblical anthropology
  - o 95% of Christians worldwide believe soul survives bodily death (Pew Research)
  - o This belief more aligned with Hinduism/Eastern religions than biblical teaching
  - o Genesis creation account doesn't support soul-body dualism

#### **Biblical Language Analysis**

- Hebrew terminology examination:
  - Naphach = breath of life (not God's spirit)
  - o Neshama = life-giving air
  - Nefesh = living, breathing being (not immortal soul)
- Nefesh usage examples:
  - Psalm 69: "waters up to my neck" (nefesh = throat/neck)
  - Deuteronomy: "kill everyone" context (nefesh = living beings)
  - o Proverbs: describes appetite (physical, not spiritual)

## **Historical Development of Soul Doctrine**

- Translation influence on doctrine:
  - o Hebrew Pentateuch translated to Greek (280-150 BC)
  - o Nefesh became psyche in Greek translation
  - o Original Hebrew meaning lost under Hellenistic influence
  - o Latin translations cemented dualistic interpretation
- Key figures in doctrinal development:
  - o Plato formalized pre-existing pagan beliefs
  - o Augustine, Thomism, Scholastics embedded soul doctrine
  - o Reformers studied Hebrew but soul doctrine persisted

## **New Testament Reinterpretation**

- Modern scholarship findings (James Dunn, E.P. Sanders, N.T. Wright):
  - o NT writers thought in Hebrew, not Greek philosophical terms
  - o Paul's anthropology based on Genesis, not Plato
  - Psychikos = animated by natural human desires (not spiritual essence)
  - o Pneumatikos = animated by Holy Spirit

- Resurrection theology:
  - o Paul teaches bodily resurrection, not disembodied spirits
  - o Jesus rose with physical body (eating, being touched)
  - o 2/3 of Americans believing in resurrection expect disembodied existence ("floaty bits")

## **Theological and Practical Concerns**

- Mystical practices critique:
  - o Silent retreats, meditation, mindfulness similar to Hindu practices
  - o Risk of bypassing Jesus as sole mediator
  - o Research shows meditation can trigger anxiety, depression, psychosis
- Spiritual hierarchy dangers:
  - Soul doctrine creates caste-like spiritual rankings
  - Leads to abuse of authority in church contexts
- Core question: Does belief in immortal soul matter for Christian faith?
