Dear Parents and Caregivers,

This little book is about the biggest truth: God is love.

Christians believe that God is **one God in three Persons**—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This is called the **Trinity**. It means that God is not lonely. God has always been a loving relationship of three Persons, sharing life together forever.

Why does this matter for your child? Because **we are made in God's image**. We were created for love, for relationship, and for life with God. From the very beginning, God wanted us to share in His love.

This book uses **simple words and bright pictures** to introduce these truths in a way that even the youngest children can enjoy. The goal is not to explain everything, but to plant seeds of wonder and joy about who God is and who we are.

As you read, you might say the words slowly, point to the pictures, and repeat the ideas often. Babies learn through rhythm and repetition. Over time, these truths will become familiar and comforting.

Remember: God loves you and your child more than you can imagine.

He is with you, always.






God's Spirit helps us learn and grow close to Him.




This is how we know what real love is: Jesus gave his life for us.






We care for each other with kindness and love.

Additional notes:

The Word is a person, Jesus, who was also known by the name Emmanuel, meaning "God with us." In the Gospel of John, we read: "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the one and only Son from the Father... No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is Himself God and is at the Father's side, has made Him known" (John 1:14,18). Everything that John wrote about Jesus, he wrote "so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name" (John 20:31).

Regarding God being called Father, it is essential that we remember He is not like our own human fathers, the term does not imply an extension or amplification of what we know of fatherhood. Rather, it is He who is the only and true loving Father, the semblance of which so many fathers on Earth fail to resemble—in the same way that although we are created in God's image, we have fallen away and are now following our own ways, no longer living as the people we were created to be. True Fatherhood is found in God alone, not in the miserable experiences we know here on Earth. But God is now restoring us, in Christ, to be the people we were always meant to be—by adoption and inclusion into His family.

At the heart of everything is Love—a divine Community that welcomes us in. This gentle, beautifully illustrated booklet introduces little ones to the mystery of God's life, the joy of Jesus' gift, and the wonder of being included in His story.

With soft words and warm images, this booklet is a first step into the Good News that we belong, we are loved, and we are never alone.
